



VIRTUAL LIVE ART 2021

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Live Art is back! With COVID-19 restrictions in 2020 postponing the 5th Annual Live Art Competition, we wanted to bring back some creativity with Virtual Live Art for 2021! This year, artists are invited to PAINT PEEL IN A DAY to compete for one of three People's Choice Awards.

1. The competition is available to all artists 18 years and older who live in Ontario, Canada.
2. All applicants must submit a completed registration form. There is no fee to register. Registration is limited to 50 on a first come, first served basis. Registration closes at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 27 or when a maximum of 50 artists have registered.
3. This event is a rain or shine event, please prepare for inclement weather.
4. Artists will paint outdoors at a location of your choosing in the Region of Peel which consists of the 3 municipalities of Mississauga, Brampton and Caledon.
5. Artists are responsible for bringing their own equipment and materials, including canvases, watercolour paper, paints, easels, chairs, stools or anything needed for your creative process. Please bring protection (i.e. drop cloth) for surfaces at the location of your preference. Please come prepared to work in outdoor conditions.
6. Acceptable media for the competition include paints (acrylic, oil, watercolour, ink etc.) as well as drawing media (charcoal, conté, gouache, graphite, pastel, etc.). Photography, digital media and lens-based art are excluded from this event.
7. Artists will submit a digital image of their artwork by 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 28, 2021. The image must be emailed to pamadevelopment@peelregion.ca and include the artist's name, location in Peel where the art was produced, title of the art (if applicable), rough dimensions and medium used. Submissions time-stamped after 6:00PM will not be considered. This is an online virtual event. Submissions other than in digital format will not be accepted.
8. All submissions will be displayed in an online showcase where the public will vote for their favourite artwork. Winners of the Peoples' Choice awards will be announced on **Saturday, September 25, during [Ontario Culture Days](#)**. Prizes will be awarded to the top three artists receiving the most votes. The winners will be asked to submit an artist's statement and a photo of themselves with the winning artwork for display on PAMA's website and social media channels.
9. Artists agree to honour the intent of the competition by starting their artwork after 8:00 a.m. on August 28, 2021 and completing it by 6:00 p.m. the same day.

10. One submission per artist.
11. Schedule of events:
 - a. **Start - 8:00 a.m.** – Artists may start creating
 - b. **Submission** - Artwork must be submitted to PAMA no later than 6:00 p.m.
 - c. **People's Choice Award Voting** - will take place online starting September 1 and ending at midnight on Friday, September 24.
 - d. **People's Choice Award Winners Announced** – Saturday, September 25
12. The winners will receive a gift card to the artist's choice of DeSerres, Curry's or Michael's in the following denominations:
 - First Place: \$250.00
 - Second Place: \$150.00
 - Third place: \$75.00
13. Peel Art Gallery, Museum and Archives (PAMA), Partners and Supporters will not be responsible for any loss or damage incurred.
14. Artwork made during the competition can be sold by the artist, after the work has been submitted and voting has ended. PAMA does not take commission from the sale of an artwork.
